- Sunday, 5/13, 1-3

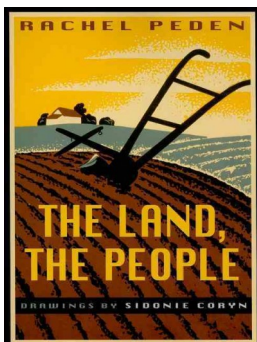
Every book you buy helps support library programs, collections, and staff development. Come early, stay late, and take home a bag of great reads!
