Arduino is an open-source electronics prototyping platform based on flexible, easy-to-use hardware and software. It's intended for artists, designers, hobbyists, and anyone interested in creating interactive objects or environments.

With an *Arduino* you can control LED lights, direct the motors in a robot, trigger sounds, make any object a game controller--the possibilities are endless.

This three-part workshop gets you up and running with *Arduino*. No programming knowledge required. Everything you need for this workshop is provided, but feel free to bring your own *Arduino* and/or laptop.
