Building Accessibility

- **Bloomington:** The Main Library has three accessible parking spots in its lot and additional metered spots on surrounding streets. Wheelchairs for public use are available at each entrance and an elevator provides access to all floors. [BTaccess](#) can provide public transportation. A [drive-up window](#) is available off of the parking lot, along with 24 hour material returns.
- **Ellettsville:** The [Ellettsville Branch](#) has two accessible parking spots and a wheelchair for public use.
