

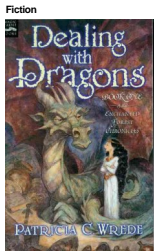

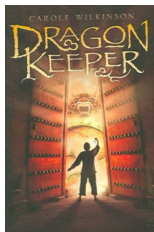
Dealing with Dragons

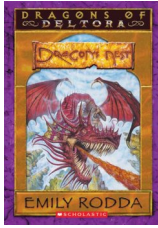
Dragon Rider

Battling famine and monsters, the people of Deltora must depend on the last dragons for help.

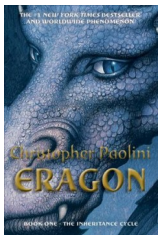
Dragonsong

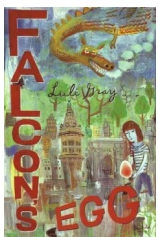
Eragon

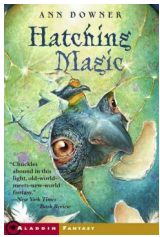
Falcon's Egg

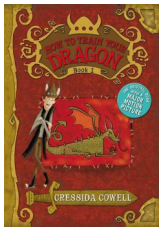


Hatching Magic

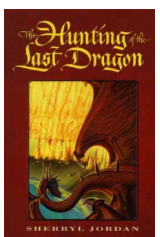
How to Train Your Dragon

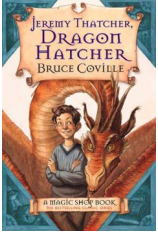


The Hunting of the Last Dragon

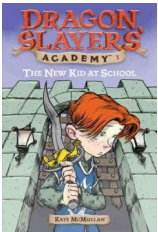
Jeremy Thatcher, Dragon Hatcher

Small for his age but artistically talented, twelve-year-old Jeremy Thatcher unknowingly buys a dragon's egg.



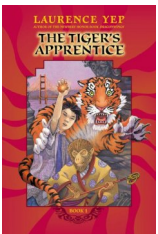
The New Kid at School

Wiglaf is off to Dragon Slayers' Academy and in for a first day of school he will never forget.



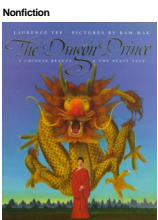
The Tiger's Apprentice

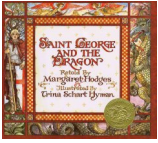


Dragon Prince: A Chinese Beauty & the Beast Tale
