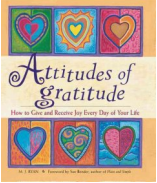

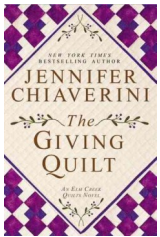


Attitudes of Gratitude: How to Give and Receive Joy Every Day of Your Life

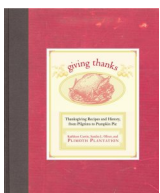


The Giving Quilt: an Elm Creek Quilts Novel

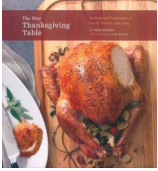

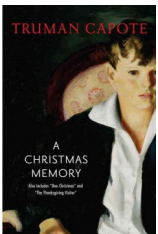


Thanksgiving : the Biography of an American Holiday

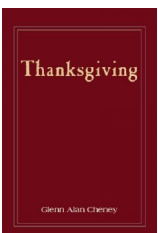


The Thanksgiving Visitor, One Christmas, and A Christmas memory

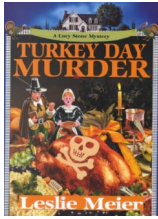


Thanksgiving: The Pilgrims' First Year in America

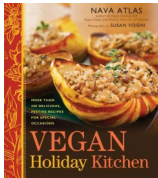
