## Predictable Books: Rhyme

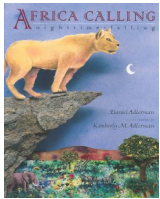
These books are examples of stories that incorporate rhyme.

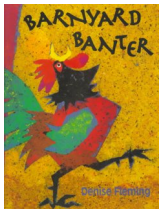


### **Africa Calling : Nighttime Falling**

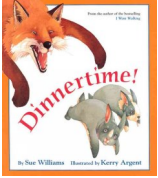

Describes simply how one family enjoys a day at the beach. Includes a list of seashells for which to look.

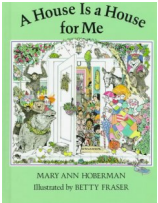


## **Dinnertime!**

Lists in rhyme the dwellings of various animals and things.

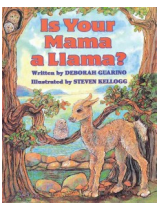


## **Is It Time?**

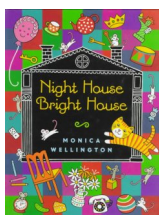
A young llama asks his friends if their mamas are llamas and finds out, in rhyme, that their mothers are other types of animals.

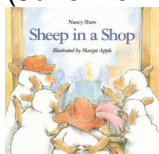

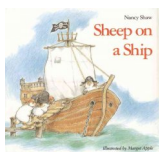


### **Sheep in a Shop**

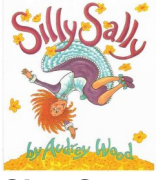
Sheep on a deep-sea voyage run into trouble when it storms and are glad to come paddling into port.

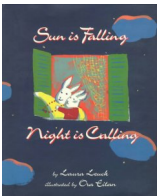
A rhyming story of Silly Sally, who makes many friends as she travels to town--backwards and upside down.

Rhyming text and illustrations describe the day's end as a mother puts her child to bed.

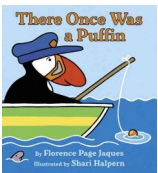


## **Sun Song**

A girl preparing for school is surprised by the number of barnyard animals gathering in the road outside.

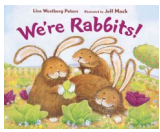


### Train Song

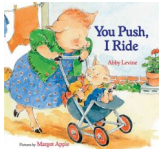
Rabbits invade a young gardener's garden in the hopes of finding carrots to eat.

A family enjoys a winter day of relaxation and fun.

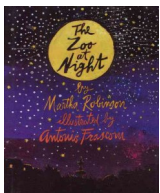


### You Push, I Ride
