

VITAL - Volunteers In Tutoring Adult Learners

Since 1977, the Monroe County Public Library has been home to one of the first library-based adult literacy programs in Indiana. Adults in VITAL improve their literacy skills to achieve their personal learning goals and dreams.

Services: Free tutoring, for adults provided by VITAL trained volunteers:

- **One-to-One Adult Literacy** tutoring to improve reading, writing, comprehension, and basic math skills.
- **One-to-One English as a New Language (ENL)** tutoring for beginning ENL learners. (if available, tutors may work with more advanced ENL learners)
- **ENL Conversation Groups** for ENL learners with intermediate or higher English conversation skills. Participants practice speaking and listening skills.
